

## EchoStar Reports First Quarter 2012 Financial Results

ENGLEWOOD, Colo., May 7, 2012 /PRNewswire/ -- EchoStar Corporation (NASDAQ: SATS) today reported total revenue of \$765 million for the quarter ended March 31, 2012, a 59 percent increase compared with \$480 million for the corresponding period in 2011.

EchoStar reported net income attributable to EchoStar of \$127 million for the quarter ended March 31, 2012, compared with net income attributable to EchoStar of \$17 million during the corresponding period in 2011. Diluted earnings per share was \$1.45 for the quarter ended March 31, 2012, compared with diluted earnings per share of \$0.19 for the corresponding period in 2011.
